

MET PROCEDURES



The bus stops for passengers before entering intersections along its route. MET Bus Stop signs are posted in some areas of the community to help in locating bus stops. **All intersections on a route are considered bus stops.** As the bus approaches, be sure that you are standing in a visible location on the proper corner.

Please stay up on the curb until the bus comes to a complete stop. **You may want to wave your hand so that the driver knows that you wish to ride.** To save time, have your fare or pass ready to show the driver. Ask for any needed transfers before taking a seat. **Please remain in your seat while the bus is in motion.** To get off the bus, pull the bell cord one block before your destination so the driver knows where you want off.

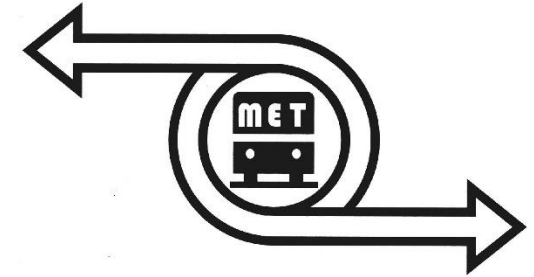

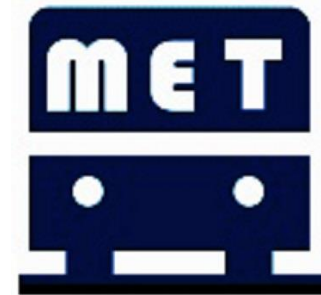
Adult 30 Day Pass \$ 50.00

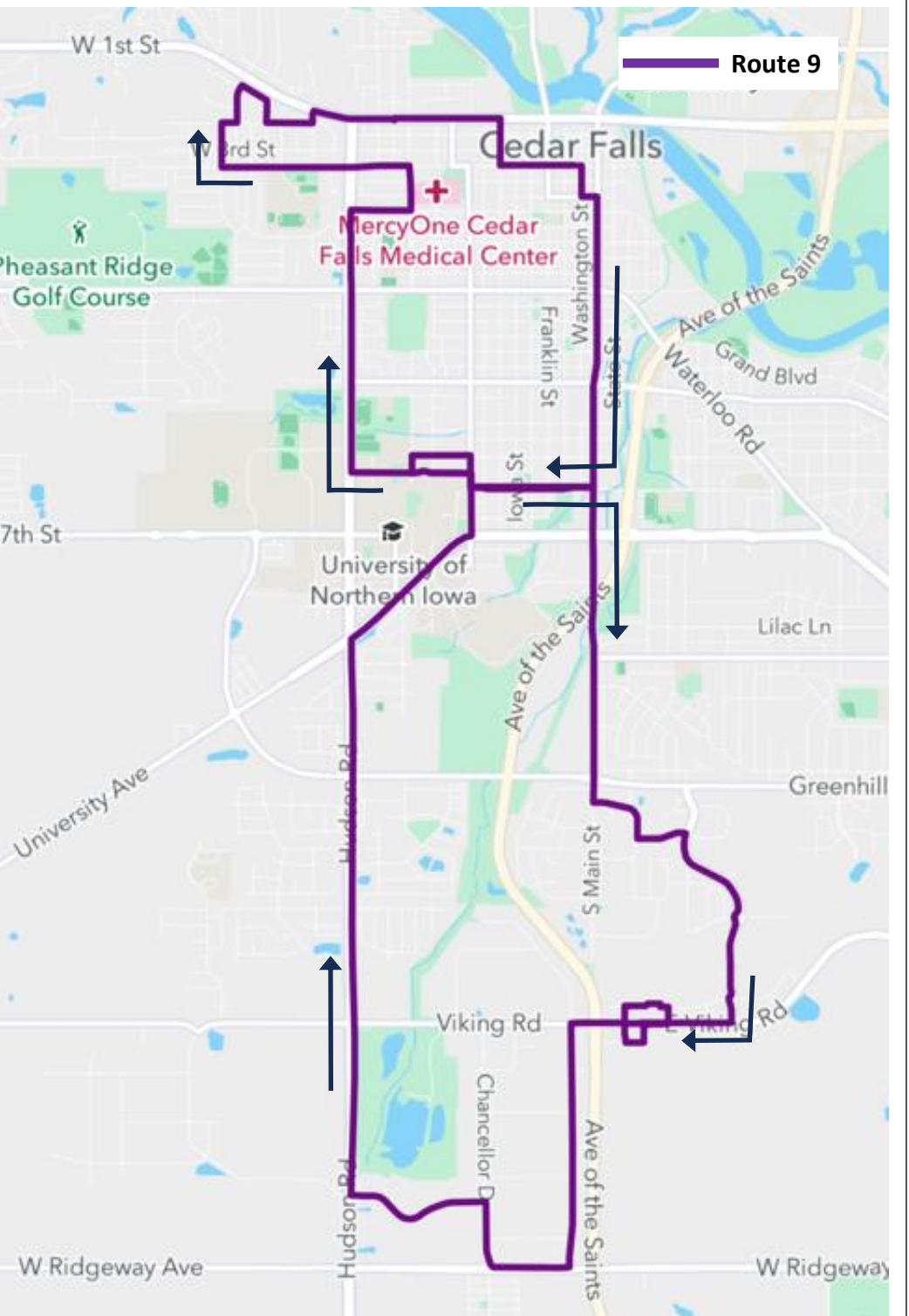
